ROCOCO WINES, CHENIN BLANC, "DELTA," PASO ROBLES, CA 2019

Natalie Brown visited the Los Alamos Vineyard in 2016 for the first time and discovered, nestled between the Santa Maria and Santa Ynez Valleys, 4 remaining acres of 40-year-old own-rooted Chenin Blanc. Since then, Rococo has honed its focus on identifying and working with old vine Chenin Blanc vineyards around California to produce expressive, site driven wines that tell a story.
