## EN CAVALE, SAUVIGNON BLANC, CONTRA COSTA, CA 2020

This winery was founded in 2017 by Wolfgang Weber and Chad Westbrook Hinds as a way to re-examine classic west coast grape varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Zinfandel through the prism of natural winemaking. The 2020 Sauvignon Blanc channels mango blossom and passionfruit before coming to grapefruit pith and lemon verbena.

## CAMINS 2 DREAMS, SYRAH, SPEAR VINEYARD, STA. RITA HILLS, CA 2018

Wife and wife team Mireia Taribo and Tara Gomez chose to combine their shared love for wine, winemaking, and each other to create Camins 2 Dreams in 2017. They focus on hand-crafted, terroir-driven wines with fruit sourced exclusively from vineyards in the Sta. Rita Hills. The spicy and peppery aromas of this Syrah blend perfectly with the notes of black fruits and earthy flavors.

## CHÂTEAU FRANC LA ROSE, ST. ÉMILION GRAND CRU, FRA 2015

The Trocard's family history can be charted back to 1620. The Chateau is now owned by Jean-Louis & Benoit Trocard, with Benoit as a 15th generation winemaker. This blend of 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Franc shows beautiful velvety tannins and fruit notes that are ample and persistent with balance and elegant structure.
